### TYPES OF IMAGES

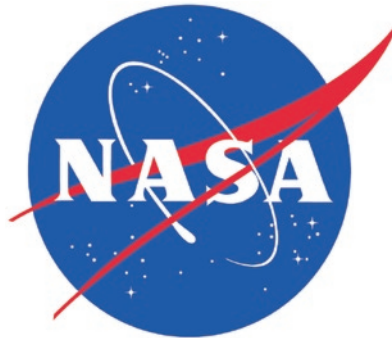
